I know I surprised them even more when I joined the Millionaire Club at Lennard High School in Hillsborough County. The premise of the club was for our students to read 1,000,000 words throughout the year. The reward for this feat was not only the knowledge they gained, but also was a trip to Tampa for a special meal, fit for a millionaire.

At the time, *Twilight* and *Divergent* were at the top of the students' reading lists, while mine was filled with murder mysteries and historical fiction. Regardless of the choice of books, we made a connection outside of the mathematics classroom through reading. The students also made lasting connections with each other too.

Today, *Twilight* may have run its course with high school students, but the positive effects of reading has not waivered. [Business Insider](#) shared in a July 20, 2017 post, "the most successful people all tend to have one thing in common: They read."
